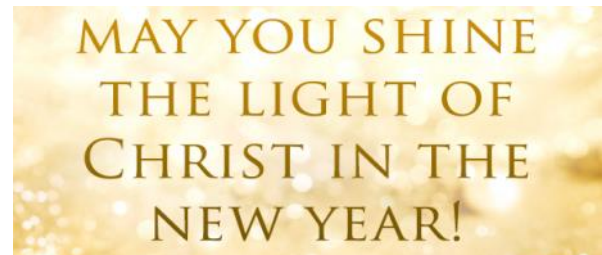

"Team Feed" is here and serving many children, families, and community folks!

We are feeding them, and they are coming. PBCC has begun a new mission to provide a meal for our Awana children on Tuesday evenings. This will be an addition to the meals that are being provided for the middle and high school students on Wednesday nights. The AWANA and Forged Youth programs are very beneficial for our young people.



Every Tuesday before AWANA Club we are serving a free dinner for AWANA kids, families, and others in our community. As of the end of November we have served 430 on AWANA night and 60 meals on Forged Youth night. Praise God for the volunteers and faithful hearts that have stepped up to make this ministry come to fruition thus far.

Each week of AWANA, we will have a nutritious meal available, **served between 5 – 5:45pm**, free of charge*. We hope that this will (among other things) help AWANA families who find themselves "flying low," trying to get their children from school and to the church for AWANA. This same menu will be prepared for our Forged Youth kids on Wednesday evenings as well.

The team that will be preparing and serving the AWANA meals on Tuesday evenings are asking families to consider how they might be able to help – either on a weekly basis, a bi-weekly, or even monthly on a rotation.

We're looking for:

- Set-up Team Members (4pm)
- Prep Team Members (4pm)
- Child care helpers (4-6:00 pm)
- Servers (5-5:45pm)
- Clean-up Team Members (5:45-6:30pm)
- Shoppers (various times)

The Mission Meal ministry meals on Tuesday evenings will follow the AWANA year calendar. The Forged Youth meals will continue being prepared and served on Wednesday evenings (as we have done this past year) and follow the public school calendar. Helpers are already in place for the Wednesday evening meals.

Communication Tips for Parents By Daniel G. Amen, MD

If children are going to survive and thrive in tomorrow's complex world, they need to practice solving as many problems as possible... today! The following process is designed to get kids thinking more about their problems than we do.

Step 1: Provide a strong and sincere dose of empathy.

Empathy allows the child to stay calm enough to solve the problem... and learn from it. Experiment with saying something like:

Oh no. This is a problem. I bet that's really upsetting.

Step 2: Hand the problem back.

After you have proven that you care, ask:

What do you think you might do to solve this problem?

Don't be shocked if the child mumbles, "I don't know."

Step 3: Ask permission to share what "some kids" have tried.

Avoid giving suggestions until you have asked:

Would you like to hear what some other kids have tried?

Step 4: Provide two or three alternatives for solving the problem.

Remember to avoid resistance by saying:

Some kids decide to _____.

How would that work for you?

Step 5: Allow the child to solve or not to solve the problem.

Resist the urge to tell the child which alternative to pick. End the session by showing your faith in the child and say: *Good luck! Let me know how this turns out.*

Contribution Record Keeping Requirements

This time of year we like to give you an update on IRS rules in regard to tax deductible contributions to your Church. While there are no changes for this year, new rules implemented in past years can be a bit confusing.

Here are the current rules:

1. If you write a check, the cancelled check is a proper record for amounts up to \$250.
2. For checks of \$250 or more, you will need a receipt from the Church which we will send out automatically at the end of each quarter.
3. If you wish to contribute cash for which you plan to take a tax deduction, you will need a receipt from the Church. We, of course, cannot provide a receipt unless we are aware of the contribution. Cash contribution envelopes are available in the Great Hall of the Worship Center and in the Fellowship Hall of the Historic Chapel. You will need to complete the required information and place the envelope with your cash in the offering box. We will then issue a proper receipt to you at the end of each quarter.
4. For Pushpay online giving, receipts will be sent out in the early part of next year. If you have any questions, contact Clay Penhollow, Director of Operations.
