

Essential Life Skills for Teens - Part 1

Giving your child chores and responsibilities doesn't just make life easier for you—it's good for them, too! When a child accomplishes something on their own or learns a new skill, it boosts their self-esteem and prepares them for adulthood. Teaching independence is not something you start when they're in their teens. It really starts with having them dress themselves when they're three and help pack their bags for camp when they're nine.

With that in mind, here are the first three life skills your kids should be doing on their own by the time they're teenagers.

1. Wake themselves up in the morning

Teens are perfectly capable of waking themselves up in the morning, and if they hit that snooze button too often, they'll quickly learn the consequences. "My foursome have been expected to get themselves up on early school mornings since they started middle school," Amy Carney, a parenting expert and a mom of four told Red Tricycle. "There are days one will come racing out with only a few minutes to spare before they have to be out the door. The snooze button no longer feels luxurious when it's caused you to miss breakfast."

Dress Sense – Clothing and Laundry Skills

When they're under the age of 12, give them simpler tasks like gathering dirty clothes, folding clean items, and putting pieces away. Then give them more responsibility when they master those tasks. By the time they're 13, they should know how to properly use a washing machine and dryer, parenting expert Kathy told Today's Parent. Your teenagers might change their style completely owing to external influences, but the chances are they may get influenced by the wrong people. So, here is how they get one of the everyday skills right.

- Picking the right-sized clothes, a decent outfit.
- Choosing the right kind of clothes for the right occasion.
- Sewing is a skill both men and women can benefit from.
- Iron a shirt, pants or suit. What is more important is to distinguish between clothes that need ironing and those that don't (we don't want them ironing their jeans now, do we?).
- Do the laundry. Teach your teen to wash clothes by hand or using a washing machine and to deal with simple stains.
- Fold clothes and put them neatly in their cupboard. You do not want a messy closet when they are at home or away.
- Pack a suitcase.
- Read and understand fabric labels.

Gently tell your teen what their clothes say about them and the level of respect they would get in certain situations such as interviews or among the opposite sex.

3. Personal Grooming

Grooming is a skill that children need to learn early on. Personal grooming is important to stay healthy and also have a good social or romantic life.

- Teach them healthy habits like brushing and bathing daily.

Explain the importance of keeping their bodies clean. They must know how to care for their skin and hair and teeth.

The best way to teach your child about these everyday living skills is to help them take care of themselves when they are at home. Avoid doing everything for them.

These are only a few among the list of life skills for teenagers they need to learn before beginning the journey as an adult. The key to a happy life is to sustain two key skills – the willingness and ability to learn new things, unlearn skills that are not useful and relearn them with a new perspective. Agreed that teaching life skills to teenagers is not easy, but if you can do that, you will have done justice to your job as a parent.


