

- (5) 25# bags of light brown sugar (*no organic crystals*)
- 1 gal Cinnamon
- 1.5 gal vegetable (canola or similar)
- 6# black raisins (not gold)
- (170) Half steamer pans
- 80# margarine- not whipped
- (2) large cans of Pam
- 4# yeast (not rapid rise)

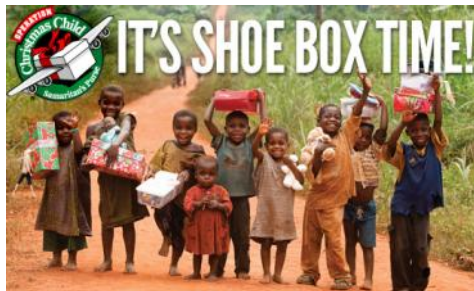
Please make your boxes FULL so when you shake them you cannot hear things moving around! Make them FUN so when the child opens it, it has fun items in it and makes them smile! ☺
