Examples of Project-Based Learning

Plant-based Eating as Medicine	Students can perform a study of self reports from participants of the effects of plant based eating on their health.
Report Writing	Students can write the history of the atomic bomb.
Create an informative website	Students can use Google Sites to create an informative website or to demonstrate their experiment and data collected.
Patent office	Students can create a collection of ideas to start a school patent office.
Case Law	Students can study case law related to patents and trademarks.
Author	Students can write a book or a play/skit relating to one of the areas of scientific study.
Talk Show	Students can create a talk show with an expert in the field to record interviews.
Show and Tell	Students can dress up as their favorite scientists and inform the other students of their accomplishments.
