Dues are \$60.00/year, payable in September.

Please wear your **name tag**. (First name tag is provided free, replacements are \$10.00.)

"Auditions" are required of new members with Dr. Carter after rehearsals.

Rehearsals are Monday nights starting at 7:00 PM sharp – 8:30 PM.

About four weeks out from the concert, rehearsals will run until 9:00 PM.

Dr. Carter will make the decision as to when late rehearsals start.

Sit in your section wherever you like but *be willing to change seats*, <u>especially</u> for performances.

Members provide their own **black folder** for concert use. Use **pencil only** when marking your music.

Please **sign in** at the door for each rehearsal.

Unless approved by Dr. Carter, three **unexcused absences** will result in not performing in the concert.

If you are **missing music**, see the music librarian (Nancy Lesslie) *before* or *after* rehearsal. Please don't ask for music during the rehearsal – just look on with someone for the moment.

Dress Rehearsal – typically the Saturday before the concert from 12-3. You do <u>not</u> need to dress. Listen for details during normal rehearsal times.

The **concert "call"** (time to show up) is usually about 2 hours before actual concert time. Listen for details during normal rehearsal times. Come dressed and ready to sing. Rehearsal room will be open between rehearsal and concert for eating and relaxing. Personal items (keys, purse, etc.) should be left in your car or the rehearsal room which will be locked.

The music librarian will announce what to do with music after a concert.

(Keep until next rehearsal or put in collection box she provides).

The **TCC Board** is a volunteer group that meets monthly to work with Dr. Carter in producing the best possible concerts. If you have comments, questions, or concerns, please contact a board member.

There are typically two "**run-outs**" in December – to Vista Royale and to Indian River Estates. These are additional rehearsals and concerts held on a week-night.
