- A credit card authorization form is required to secure your spot on this trip. if you are making deposit for more than one person please include the name and birthdate of each traveler on the form. Travel Insurance is strongly recommended - MUST BE secured prior to the final trip payment 3/5/20.
- An Executed Decline of travel insurance waiver is required for any guest wishing to not purchase trip insurance.
- Statements will go out on or before the 1st of each month. Automatic payments will be drafted on the 5th of each month.
- If you are joining this trip after December 31, 2019, you will need to pay \$250 deposit and all monthly installments you have missed to bring you up to date. No exceptions to this policy. Auto drafts can ONLY be set up for the 1st or the 5th of each month.

Half Day Excursion to Totumo Volcano

Day 2 - May 13, 2020

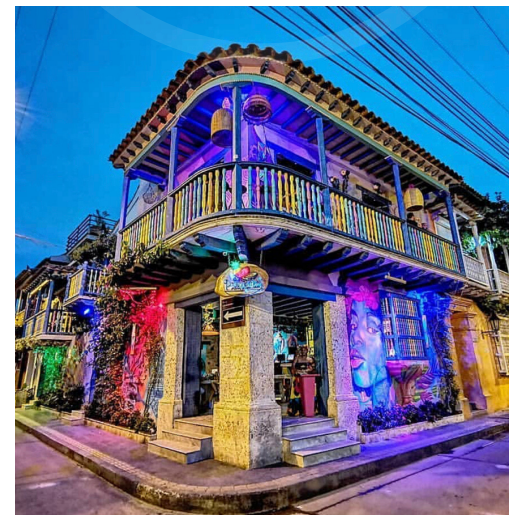
