

Speed	Professional crews working together finish WAY faster than solo painters; experienced teams cover 150-200 sq ft per hour	Efficient doesn't mean rushed! The best painters have systems in place, prep teams, paint teams, cleanup crews working in parallel.

What to Actually Look For When Choosing House Painters Near You

3. Ask About Their Crew and Process

- "How many people will be on my project?"
- "What's your prep process look like?"
- "What brands of paint do you typically use and why?"
- "Are your crew members employees or subcontractors?"
- "Do you background-check your team?"

Professional painting companies LOVE these questions because it gives us a chance to brag about our process! If someone gets defensive or vague? Major red flag.

4. Verify Insurance and Licensing

Look, accidents happen. Paint spills on hardwood floors, ladders tip over, someone drops a can off scaffolding. You NEED a painter who's:

- Bonded (this protects you if they disappear mid-project)
