WAYS TO PARTNER

The Great Maryland Recipe Hunt (GMRH) is seeking partnerships with organizations in Maryland such as libraries, museums, historic sites, senior centers, schools, government agencies, community centers, and others to spread the word and encourage Marylanders to submit recipes and/or food memories to the hunt.

There is no fee and partners are free to choose the level at which they want to participate. Here are the options:

1. Social Media Posts/Email Blasts

Please encourage your members/audience to participate in the hunt by posting announcements/reminders on your social media accounts or in email blasts. GMRH logos and a schedule of suggested post themes and dates are available on the website (www.marylandrecipes.org).

The official GMRH launch is scheduled for September 1, 2022, and the topic is Labor Day party/picnic foods. Hunt partners are free to make their own posts or, they can download pre-made posts from the GMRH website.

2. Link to GMRH Website

Sites are encouraged to place a link to the GMRH website, along with the logo and a brief description of the project.

3. Generate Partnerships

We need your help spreading the word! You can increase the network of partners by raising awareness of the GMRH to other organizations to encourage additional partnerships.

4. Host a GMRH Virtual Webinar

A GMRH committee member can be your guest for a webinar you advertise and host to discuss Maryland food and the recipe hunt. Participants can learn more about the goals of the hunt and ask questions about ways they can contribute to the collection.

5. Host a GMRH Collection Day

Invite your members to drop in to your site where they can meet with GMRH representative with whom they can share their memories of Maryland food in the form of an oral history interview, or they can simply stop by so that their favorite recipes can be scanned. Partner sites are free to make this day as simple or as elaborate as they choose by hosting pot-luck suppers, recipe contests, festivals, etc.

INTRODUCING A FOOD HISTORY PROJECT THAT REFLECTS EVERYONE'S HISTORY

In 1963, *Maryland's Way, The Hammond-Harwood House Cook Book* was published to document and share recipes from historic manuscript documents and contributors from across the state. Over the course of almost 60 years, the cookbook's success has generated numerous reprints and has become a vital component of Maryland's heritage tourism.

To mark the book's 60th anniversary, please help revitalize the effort to collect, document and preserve the diversity of Maryland's continually evolving cuisine. This will include the convergence of Native American, African American, British, German and Jewish traditions with more recent contributions made by immigrants from southern and Eastern Europe, Asia, Latin America, and likely even further afield.

This hunt will help preserve Maryland's foodways for generations to come. Future print and digital publications based on hunt findings will help interpret and define Maryland's culinary past as an inclusive cultural resource reflecting ever-increasing diversity and dynamic change over time.
