

Position Title: Worship Leader

Position Summary: The Worship Leader will serve as the primary leader of Saturday evening contemporary worship at Antioch Community Church. This role is responsible for planning, preparing, and leading worship that draws people into the presence of God and supports the mission of the church.

- Knowledge of a wide range of worship music genres.
- Commitment to Antioch's mission and vision.
- The ability to play an instrument is preferred but not required.
