FALL AT ONE OF LEXINGTON'S MOST BELOVED LANDMARKS

Did you know that Lexington is called the "Horse Capital of the World"? One of the best ways to experience this is with a visit to Keeneland, a world-famous Thoroughbred racing facility right here in Lexington.

Keeneland hosts two racing meets each year, in April and October. The upcoming Fall Meet is October 3-25, 2025. Racing begins on a Friday and then continues in the afternoons Wednesday through Sunday (no races on Mondays or Tuesdays). Meets at Keeneland draw large crowds, especially on weekends with nice weather. Many like to dress up and enjoy an afternoon of horse racing, food, and fun.

Another way to experience Keeneland is to get breakfast at the Track Kitchen. Open early each morning, it serves hearty, homestyle favorites like eggs, bacon or sausage, biscuits and gravy, and breakfast sandwiches. On Saturdays during the Fall Meet, you can also head to Sunrise Trackside from 8–10 AM, where you can enjoy coffee and light breakfast options while you watch the horses train on the track.

Even when the meets aren't running,
Keeneland's grounds are open all year and free
to visit. If you arrive early on most mornings, you
can see the horses during their training
workouts on the track. Tours and special
experiences are also offered, for a unique
behind-the-scenes look at one of Kentucky's
most beloved landmarks.

<u>Shillito Park</u> - 300 W. Reynolds Road, multiple parking options, some bathrooms. Total loop is 2.4 miles

<u>The UK Arboretum</u> - 500 Alumni Drive, bathrooms next to the parking lot. Total loop is 2 miles
