ELECTION DAY IN THE U.S.

The General Election is always the Tuesday after the first Monday in November every year. This means the actual date varies from year to year. It will be November 5th this year and there is no school that day for Fayette County Schools.

Many schools are off on this day as one or more schools in any given school district may be used as a voting location (also called polling stations). Other polling stations may include churches, fire stations, libraries and more.

The office of United States President (and Vice President) is only elected every four years. As you have likely noticed, this is a presidential election year!

Any United States citizen who is 18 years of age or older is eligible to vote, but must register first. The deadline for registration for this election has already passed.

Everyone voting will see a variety of local offices and amendments on their ballot. These vary based on where you live – your state, your city, and even your district.

Kentucky voters can view their sample ballot ahead of time (<u>click here to see</u>) so that they can be aware of all of their choices before they vote.

Also in recent years, early in-person voting has become more common. The timing and rules vary by state. In Kentucky, early voting begins Thursday, October 31st. All voting must be complete when your state's polling locations close on Election Day. Here in Kentucky, polling locations are open from 6AM to 6PM.

Are you new to the U.S.? We have a few tips below so that you know what to expect for Trick-or-Treating on October 31st.

- Trick-or-Treating is going door-to-door in your neighborhood in a costume to gather small treats. Only Trick-or-Treat during the hours of 6-8PM on Halloween night.
- Parents should always accompany children, and can wear costumes if they like, but only children do the "Trick-or-Treating"
- A porch light ON usually means that home is participating.
- The sun will set during these hours take a flashlight for after dark.
- Watch out for traffic, pets, and scary decorations or costumes that might upset young children - you can steer them away or avoid that house.

If you don't want to go out Trick-or-Treating (or you don't have kids), handing out treats at your home is a great way to meet your neighbors! Turn your porch light on as a signal that you are participating. Only hand out store-bought, individually wrapped candy, or very small toys (like plastic rings, bouncy balls, stickers and fun erasers). If you don't want to participate, that's okay! Keep your porch light off and the front door closed that night.
