THE KENTUCKY DERBY

The first Saturday in May is an exciting day in Kentucky! All eyes turn to our neighbors in Louisville, where the world-famous Kentucky Derby is held at Churchill Downs. The main race, when 3-year-old Thoroughbred horses race 1.25 miles, is often called the "Run for the Roses," because the winning horse is draped with a blanket of beautiful red roses. It is also called the "Fastest Two Minutes in Sports" because the race itself is that short!

The Kentucky Derby is not just a race—it is a celebration of Kentucky's long history of horse culture. Horse breeding, training, and racing are a major part of life and the economy here.

People celebrate with Derby Day parties, dressing up in spring dresses and nice suits, and wearing fancy hats. Hats are an important tradition, going back to the very beginning,, and became even more popular when the race started being shown on TV in the 1950s. It turned the event into a kind of national fashion show!

Today, wearing a Derby hat is a beloved Southern tradition. Derby hats for women range from small and elegant to big and extravagant, often decorated with feathers, flowers, and ribbons.

The 151st Kentucky Derby will be held on Saturday, May 3rd, airing live on NBC and streaming on Peacock.




Sunday May 11th is Mother's Day In the U.S.
