Georgia Women's Golf Association's Grant program started in 2008. Funds for grants come primarily from our members' tax deductible donations. The purpose of our grant program is to financially assist organizations that promote girls and/or women golf programs. Funds may be used for equipment, team/group uniforms, team/group entry fees and teaching aids and must be specifically dedicated to the female golf programs. To date we have proudly contributed to over 41 girls' school golf programs.

In 2017, GWGA awarded Grant Funds to 5 school programs for girls' golf: Ashworth Middle School, Cedartown High School, Gordon Central High School, Veterans High School, and Woodward Academy.
