Georgia Women's Golf Association Grant purpose is to assist an organization through funds to develop, promote, maintain and protect the best interests of the game of golf among amateur female golfers throughout the State of Georgia. An organization that promotes girls and/or women golf programs is eligible to apply for one of the minimum \$500.00/maximum \$1000.00 Grants. These funds may be used for equipment, team/group uniforms, team/group entry fees, and teaching aids.

Send or email the completed Grant Application and any supporting documentation to the contact information provided on the last page before the deadline, **June 01, 2019**.

The GWGA Grant Committee will rate each section on the Grant application using the following scale:

- 4—Excellent/exceeds requirements
- 3—Very good
- 2—Good
- 1—Poor
- 0-Did not address

The Recipients receiving awards from the Grant Fund will be determined during the June GWGA Board meeting and announced at the Georgia Women's State Amateur Champions Banquet on June 27, 2019. A Board member will contact The "Primary Application Contact" to inform them of the award. The Grant checks will be mailed/delivered after October 1, 2019 and picture(s) of the awarding of the Grant Funds will appear on the GWGA website.
