

## **To all families in the Boulder Valley School District --**

It has come to our attention that there may be many students registered with the Boulder Valley School District who are of multiple races/ethnicities (including American Indian/Alaskan Native/Native Hawaiian) and who are NOT receiving FREE community events, resources and supports from the Title 6 federal grant due to a quirk registering students of multiple races/ethnicities on the District enrollment form:

When enrolling a student in Boulder Valley School District, the form will ask the student's race.

Whatever ONE race the registering parent/guardian chooses for this initial race question ("Hispanic," "African-American," "Asian-American," "White," etc.) that is the ONLY racial designator the child is allowed.

This will designate that student as that ONE race for Federal and State racial demographics tracking.

To designate a BVSD student(s) as wholly or partly American Indian/Alaskan Native/Native Hawaiian (and qualify to receive access to FREE Title 6 community events, resources and supports) the registering parent/guardian must:

(1) choose "American Indian/Alaskan Native/Native Hawaiian" for the initial ONE race question,

OR

(2) if the student is multiple-race/ethnicity (INCLUDING American Indian/Alaskan Native/Native Hawaiian) the registering parent may choose another race to answer for the initial race question and then MUST CHOOSE "American Indian/Alaskan Native/Native Hawaiian" for the ethnicity question (multiple ethnicities may be chosen if applicable to the student).

\*\*\* If the registering parent/guardian does not choose "American Indian/Alaskan Native/Native Hawaiian" for race and/or ethnicity in this way, then the student will not be included in the Title 6 student list and will miss out on FREE community events, resources and supports provided to Title 6 students and families. \*\*\*
