

PLYMOUTH WATER DISTRICT
MEETING MINUTES
4/12/23

Present: Judy Lear, Austin Wyatt, Steve Hale

Meeting called to order at 3:11 p.m. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with corrections. Monthly water report was satisfactory. Discussion about repairs to fire hydrants and the fact that some of the valves are inaccessible. Austin will contact someone to get quotes for the repairs. Vouchers and P-cards were read and approved. Talked about buying chlorine in bulk with another chlorine user.

Financial report was given. Reviewed the aging report; one shut-off notice to be sent out. It was reported that NW Water Management was working on plans for PWD to furnish water to the entire Industrial park through Riverpoint Farms. The water valve to the onion plant was shut off and accidentally not turned back on, so their tank was low and they had to fill their reservoir last week. Everything is back to normal.

Discussion about how the water will be metered/charged for receiving water through River Point Farms.


A motion was made to give Austin 1 year to remove his personal property from the PWD compound; seconded and passed. Discussion about Austin being reimbursed for funds he spent on his own for connecting to DeVere's well. It was suggested that in order for this to happen 1) DeVere's well had to be approved by DOH and 2) there needs to be something in writing to the PWD from Todd from NW Water Management that DeVere's well would be able to work as needed in conjunction with another well and be beneficial to the District.

Discussion again about the BNSF well. Steve will write up another letter to send to them about purchasing/leasing the well. Discussion about water rates and usage during the summer months. Austin will present a proposal at the next meeting.
