- 2nd Grade – Try adding numbers that involve crossing a decade number (10,20, 30,40, etc) such as $27 + 8 =$
- 3rd grade – Try making an In/Out Table for a family member to solve. Make sure you have the rules for them!
- Email your teacher and ask for 4-6 math problems

Challenge Work:

Mr. Horton is building a floor in his back room. The Length of the room is 16 feet. The width is 10 feet. He needs to put down carpet over the floor at a cost of \$2.00 a square foot. How much will the carpet cost for this room?
