**Math:**

- Ask a family member to give you 10 problems to solve and work on them below.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Grade – Try Adding 10, 20, 30, to two-digit numbers. ( $52 + 10$ )
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – Try adding numbers that involve crossing a decade number (10,20, 30,40, etc) such as  $27 + 8 =$
- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade – Try making an In/Out Table for a family member to solve. Make sure you have the rules for them!
- Email your teacher and ask for 4-6 math problems
