## Sermon Notes

### "Pray for One Another"

James 5:16  
Colossians 4:2

#### 1. Prayer and Jesus

- A. Luke 11:1, "Lord, teach us to pray."
- B. Jesus' example
  1. Mark 1:35 - rose early to pray
  2. Luke 5:16 - withdrew to lonely places and prayed
  3. Luke 6:12 - spent the night praying
- C. Why did Jesus need to pray?
  1. He needed to demonstrate a dependence upon God
  2. He needed to seek God's will, not his own
- D. If we attempt to do things for God without prayer, He can not afford the risk of allowing us to succeed. For we would become hardened in our belief that activism, not dependence upon God, is the way for the Christian to live.

#### 2. Prayer and the Congregation

- A. Prayer must be taught to be "child-like".
- B. Prayer must follow the pattern of the first-century church.
  1. communion - Acts 20:7
  2. prayer - Acts 1:14, 2:42, 3:1, 4:24, 12:12, 13:3, 20:36
- C. Our days must be bathed in prayer.
- D. Prayer must be used in counseling.
- E. Our leadership must be bathed in prayer.
- F. Our neighborhoods must be bathed in prayer.
- G. Prayer must be the basis of all we do.

#### 3. What Now?

When this church devotes itself to prayer as God intends, then other people and other congregations in this community will desire to pattern their lives and their congregations after you. Will you be the person who is devoted to prayer? Will you be the congregation that is devoted to prayer?

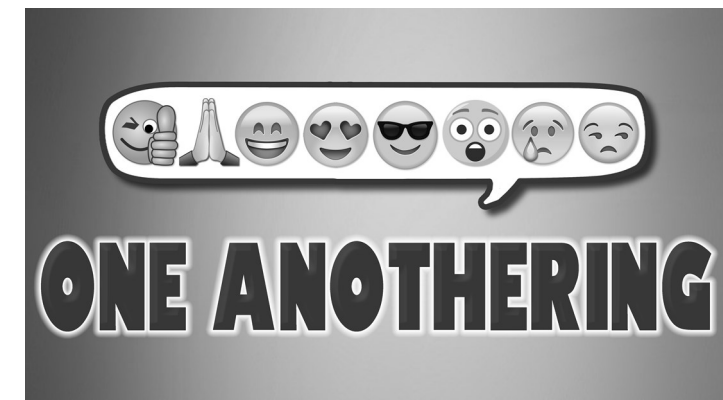
