## **SPRINGTIME ON THE FARM!!! SPRING INTO HAVING FUN GETTING THOSE TITLES!**

**FARM DOG CERTIFIED:** Open to all dogs with any type of AKC registration. This is a manners test done on leash and does not require direct contact with livestock or having anyone other than the handler touch the dog. You will need two legs to earn this title.

### **FARM DOG TEST OUTLINE**

#### **1. Greet Evaluator.**

Initial Dog Appraisal Handler approaches evaluator, dog stops at handler's side on a loose lead while evaluator performs introduction.

#### **2. Perform a Walk Pattern around Farm Environment and by Passive Stranger.**

The handler walks the dog on a loose lead in a prescribed pattern through farm objects. A passive stranger sits quietly on course.

#### **3. Jump on Hay/Straw Bale.**

The handler instructs the dog to jump up on a bale of hay and stay on the bale for a minimum of 10 seconds while maintaining a loose lead.

#### **4. Walk by Farm Animal(s).**

The handler walks the dog on a loose lead in view of penned farm animal(s) approximately 30 feet away from the fence line housing farm animal(s).

#### **5. Walk Over or Through Unusual Surfaces.**

The handler walks the dog on a loose lead over or through three different unusual surfaces, including a plastic tarp, safe wooded surface, and another typical farm environment surface.

#### **6. Supervised Separation.**

The handler places the dog in a freestanding kennel or dog crate and walks out of sight for a minimum of 1 minute.

#### **7. Pass Through a Gate .**

The handler and dog navigate through a gate on a loose lead, the dog must wait calmly as the handler opens the gate, calls dog through the gate opening and closes the gate.

#### **8. Handler Feeds Livestock .**

The handler performs a farm chore of feeding farm animals while the dog is secured a minimum of 30 feet away from the animal enclosure.

#### **9. Reaction to Another Dog.**

The handler is positioned in a designated area with the dog at side on loose lead. The dog may stand, down or sit. Another dog is walked by on lead approximately 10 feet away.

#### **10. Reaction to Noise Distraction.**

The handler may stand or quietly walk in a designated area with the dog at side on loose lead. The assistant creates two background noises typical to a working farm environment.

#### **11. Dog Approaches Livestock.**

The handler, with the dog at side on a loose lead, enters a fenced area that contains livestock within a separate enclosure. The dog is introduced to livestock and encouraged to approach the pen, the dog is then called back to the handler and returns readily when called.

#### **12. Physical Examination.**

The handler physically examines the dog for any plant material, debris or objects that the dog may have collected while working on the farm.

**OVERALL TEST ASSESSMENT:** Was the dog consistently responsive to the handler and successfully exhibited self-control while exposed to a farm environment?

Dogs that pass Farm Dog Certification Tests under two different judges are eligible for a Farm Dog Certified Title. An application form for the title is included in the premium list for the convenience of exhibitors.

## ABOUT THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB TEMPERAMENT TEST

The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) is a general temperament test for all breeds and mixed breed dogs that will assess the dog's reaction to a variety of stimuli. These stimuli will be in the following six categories: Social, Auditory, Visual, Tactile (touch), Proprioceptive (motion) and Unexpected Stimuli. The purpose of the ATT is to test for fear, shyness, inability to recover, and lack of cooperation. Desired traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, appropriately social for its breed, biddable, and demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time. Dogs who show signs of aggression will not pass the test.

One purpose of the ATT is to educate dog owners about the temperament of their breeds. At each test, in addition to a title application form and their contact information on the evaluator's checklist, handlers complete the form labeled, "Your Breed's Temperament." The form includes a space for the handlers of mixed breed dogs to write about the temperament of their individual dogs. Clubs are required to print the Breed Temperament Guide

and have copies on the registration table and/or a poster.

### TEST INFO

The ATT is a non-competitive pass-fail test. In a test, a dog must pass 3 test items in each of the six categories (total of 18 test items). These are selected from a list of 24 possible test items. All dogs who pass the ATT twice under two different approved ATT Evaluators may earn the AKC Temperament Test (ATT) Title.

### PRIZES

Each dog that passes an AKC Temperament Test will receive a flat white qualifying ribbon.

Dogs that pass ATT under two different judges are eligible for an AKC Temperament Test Title. An application form for the title will be available on site and is listed below list for the convenience of exhibitors. Owners will need to complete the application form and send it and the appropriate fee to the American Kennel Club; the SNCKC will not do this submission for exhibitors, but will help Juniors with the form.

**Canine Good Citizen:** Open to all dogs regardless of registration status. The evaluator will test your dog's basic manners and training including tolerance for handling, grooming, polite greeting, and a brief separation from the handler. Your dog will need to be able to sit, lay down, and stay for this test.

**Canine Good Citizen Advanced:** Open to all dogs with any type of AKC registration. This is a test of basic manners and leash walking skills in a community or event environment.

**Trick Dog (all levels Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Performer):** Open to all dogs with any type of AKC registration. The dog must demonstrate ten tricks from the list of tricks for the appropriate level. Dogs must have completed all prior level titles before earning the next title. We will have props available including crates.

Dogs must wear a secure, well-fitting flat collar during the test evaluation and be held on a properly fixed length leash at all times while on the farm site, unless confined in a crate, kennel or vehicle. The leash shall be four to six feet in length. No prong or electronic collars, head halters, harnesses are permitted on premises.

**NO FLEXI-TYPE RETRACTABLE LEASHES ALLOWED ON SITE.**

You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in the proper receptacles. A failure to do so could result in you and your dog being dismissed from the trial grounds and be barred from competing.

Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting herding stock or to interfere outside the testing area with another dog's performance in the test areas. The Judge may request the removal of any dog from the immediate test area at any time if they determine the presence of the dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs, or persons on the farm or the test site.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Course Director will be responsible or obligated to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents.

Officers, club members and committee members shall assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for injury to you, children or dogs. YOU ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccination is required for all animals.

Children must be accompanied by and kept under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.

Please follow the parking directions.

Please vacate the premises upon completion of the tests.

Bring your own chair, shade and water for your dogs. Dress appropriately for the weather.

## **Farm Dog Certified Tests - Open to all Breeds**

The AKC Farm Dog Certified (FDC) Test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or neutered dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

**Females in season may not participate.** Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the entire course.

**ENTRIES OPEN FOR ALL TESTS ON January 2, 2026**

*Please do not send early entries: they will be refused.*

**Pre-entries Close for all: THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2026 at 1 pm EST at the home of the test secretary.**

**All Entries Limited to 30 runs per event.**

Day of entries will be accepted, if maximum limit is not reached at closing.

## **AKC Temperament Tests - Open to all Breeds**

The AKC Temperament is open to all dogs who are **at least 1 year of age** are eligible to take the ATT and must either be AKC or FSS registered or listed with Canine Partners or have a Purebred Alternative Listing number. Dogs that are spayed or neutered may participate. Dogs must be able to perform whole categories of the test (such as hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), in order to be eligible to earn an ATT title. Dogs with disabilities such as those that are blind, deaf, or have three legs are eligible to enter provided in the opinion of the evaluator they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test. However, if a dog has multiple disabilities such that, it is unable to complete whole categories of the test (i.e. - hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), the dog would not earn the ATT title. Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, martingales and body harnesses in the ATT. They may not wear prong collars, head collars, e-collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4ft. to 6ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather. **Females in season may not participate.**

 FARM DOG: All dogs nine months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in herding tests and trials. Dogs classified as Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) may participate in tests and trials.

Bitches in season ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.  
 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for the test or trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any test or trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his or her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (for complete rule refer to Chap. 14, Sect 3 of Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows)

**AGREEMENT**

## **Farm Dog Certified Tests - Open to all Breeds**

The AKC Farm Dog Certified (FDC) Test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or neutered dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

**Females in season may not participate.** Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the entire course.

*Please do not send early entries: they will be refused.*

**Pre-entries Close for all: THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2026 at 1 pm EST at the home of the test secretary.**

## **AKC Temperament Tests - Open to all Breeds**

The AKC Temperament is open to all dogs who are **at least 1 year of age** are eligible to take the ATT and must either be AKC or FSS registered or listed with Canine Partners or have a Purebred Alternative Listing number. Dogs that are spayed or neutered may participate. Dogs must be able to perform whole categories of the test (such as hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), in order to be eligible to earn an ATT title. Dogs with disabilities such as those that are blind, deaf, or have three legs are eligible to enter provided in the opinion of the evaluator they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test. However, if a dog has multiple disabilities such that, it is unable to complete whole categories of the test (i.e. - hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), the dog would not earn the ATT title. Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, martingales and body harnesses in the ATT. They may not wear prong collars, head collars, e-collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4ft. to 6ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather. **Females in season may not participate.**

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for the test or trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any test or trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his or her name.
