Family-Like Atmosphere

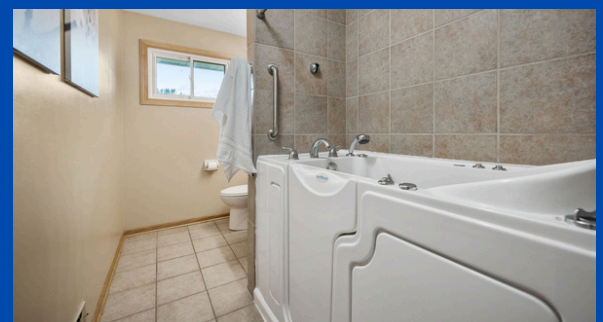
