# 2024 Summer Guest Artists



**George Miklas**, World-renown harmonicaist, grew up learning the art of playing the harmonica. From the age of ten, he participated in harmonica clubs in his home state of Ohio. In 1977, at the age of twelve, George attended his first Society for the Preservation and Advancement of the Harmonica (SPA) convention, of which he has attended faithfully for over forty years. George was inducted into the National Traditional Country Music Association Hall of Fame accepting an award in honor of his work with Jerry Murad's Harmonicats. In 2016, George performed at the Asia Pacific Harmonica Festival in Hsinchu City, Taiwan with, fellow chromatic harmonica player, Chris Bauer. George holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Music Education from Youngstown State University, Dana School of Music, a Master of Education degree in Special Education from Slippery Rock University, a Master of Arts in Music Education-Performance with a primary emphasis in Harmonica and secondary emphasis in Tuba at Liberty University. He also holds a Doctorate of Music Education at Liberty University School of Music. His thesis is titled, Harmonica Pedagogy for the Full Inclusion Music Classroom, Expanding Opportunities for Students with Disabilities in the Instrumental Music Curriculum. Dr. Miklas' research has uncovered historical records and has considered contemporary applications of the harmonica in symphonic works, Broadway pit orchestras, worship music, music education, music therapy, and respiratory therapy.



**Danielle Roby**, holds a Bachelor in Vocal Music from Old Dominion University and a Masters in Education from The University of Virginia. 
