

Col. Halvorsen Tribute

December 9th Sandler Center Concert

COL Gail Seymour "The Candy Bomber" Halvorsen (October 10, 1920 – February 16, 2022) was a senior officer and command pilot in the United States Air Force. He is best known as the "Berlin Candy Bomber" or "Uncle Wiggly Wings" and gained fame for dropping candy to German children during the Berlin Airlift from 1948 to 1949.

Halvorsen grew up in rural Utah and always had a desire to fly. He earned his private pilot's license in 1941 and then joined the Civil Air Patrol. He joined the United States Army Air Forces in 1942 and was assigned to Germany on July 10, 1948, to be a pilot for the Berlin Airlift. Halvorsen piloted C-47s and C-54s during the Berlin airlift ("Operation Vittles"). During that time he founded "Operation Little Vittles", an effort to raise morale in Berlin by dropping candy via miniature parachute to the city's residents. Halvorsen began "Little Vittles" with no authorization from his superiors but over the next year became a national hero with support from all over the United States.[5] Halvorsen's operation dropped over 23 tons of candy to the residents of Berlin. He became known as the "Berlin Candy Bomber", "Uncle Wiggly Wings", and "The Chocolate Flier".

Halvorsen received numerous awards for his role in "Operation Little Vittles", including the Congressional Gold Medal. However, "Little Vittles" was not the end of Halvorsen's military and humanitarian career. Over the next 25 years, Halvorsen advocated and performed candy drops in Bosnia-Herzegovina, Albania, Japan, Guam, and Iraq.[9] Halvorsen's professional career included various notable positions. He helped to develop reusable manned spacecraft as the Directorate of Space and Technology and served as commander of Berlin Tempelhof Airport.

He retired in August 1974 after logging over 8,000 flying hours. From 1976 until 1986 Halvorsen served as the Assistant Dean of Student Life at Brigham Young University. Col. Halvorsen passed away this year on February 16, 2022. Tidewater Winds pays respect to this man who was a national hero and a friend to so many in need. Thank you, Col. Halvorsen and all veterans, for your service and acts of courage, bravery, and example of what it means to be free.

The Regent University Singers (under the Direction of Gary Spell)

In 2013, Regent University was inspired to introduce music onto its campus. Regent University had already distinguished itself artistically with its Film, Television, and Theatre Schools, but they believed the time was right to add music. So, they commissioned a vocal ensemble that could serve as a musical ambassador for the school. It has taken some time to make that vision a reality, but in 2014, auditions were held, and The Regent University Singers were born. This 12-member ensemble specializes in A cappella music and performs mostly original arrangements at high-profile events on behalf of the school. Under their founding Director, Gary Spell, The Regent University Singers are distinguishing themselves among the nation's elite vocal ensembles. Having worked with singing groups such as Building 429, Sanctus Real, and Phil Wickham, Cory Asbury, and Jason Gray, the Regent University Singers are raising the bar for Christian and A cappella music.

Gary Spell, The Regent University Singers Music Director

Gary Spell is a native of Virginia Beach, VA. Following high school, Gary began working professionally in theater as a Musical Director and Director. After several years, Gary became the Producing Artistic Director of Dominion Theater, a professional stock theater, where he served for 9 years until the year 2000. Following 40+ productions at the theatre, Gary went into full-time ministry at Glad Tidings Church where he served a total of 12 years, eventually becoming Executive Pastor, and Worship Pastor at London Bridge Baptist Church for 6 years. Today he serves as the Senior Pastor for Tapestry Church and Founding Director of The Regent University Singers. An accomplished playwright, composer, and arranger, Gary has multiple published musical works, many of which have been a part of the City of Virginia Beach's entertainment productions for over 20 years.

Band-Together is a pilot program that provides instrumental music instruction for individuals with and without disabilities on traditional band instruments (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, percussion.) Taught by Ms. Karen Jackson and Ms. Beckie Jones, both veteran band teachers with experience with people with disabilities, the program offers individual or small group lessons and a weekly evening ensemble rehearsal starting in September, 2021.

The objectives of the Band-Together pilot program are to:

- Provide a high level of instrumental music instruction for individuals of all abilities.
- Give individuals with disabilities the opportunity to learn a band instrument.
- Teach group cooperation, team work and ensemble playing skills.
- Bring people in the community together to perform and enjoy music, supporting each other in an ensemble experience.


