Following a distinguished 26-year career as a U.S. Navy trumpet instrumentalist, Don has become known for his playing of various seashell horns. His conch shell playing can be heard throughout the soundtrack of Reese Witherspoon's production of *Where the Crawdads Sing* composed by Academy Award-winning composer, Mychael Danna. Other film recording projects include his conch shell work with Trevor Morris on *Vikings Valhalla*; Aiko Fukushima on *Samurai Rabbit*; and more. His original music and arrangements can be heard on Spotify, Apple Music, YouTube Video and other streaming platform worldwide.



Frank Cubillo, (Aug 14, 17th Street Stage) Born in Brooklyn and raised in Huntington, NY, Frank Cubillo is the "voice" and "energy" behind "FRANK SINGS FRANK", a unique Frank Sinatra Tribute singing/entertainment act that has been very popular in the Hampton Roads area of South-Eastern Virginia for more than a decade. 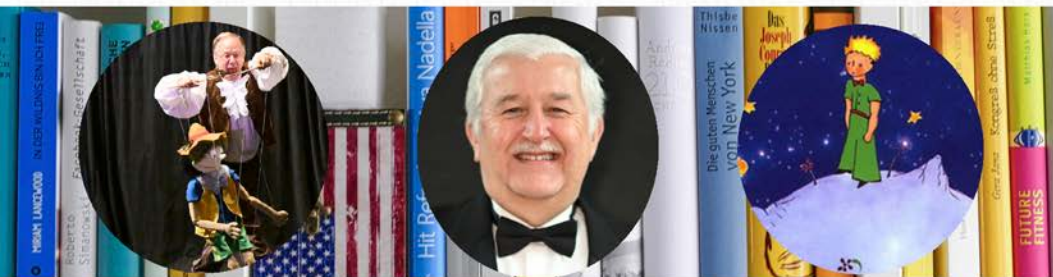

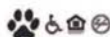
