Requirements for consideration:

- Organizations must be a registered nonprofit
- Organizations must serve youth, 5-24 years of age
- Organizations must be located within a 20 mile radius of either Mt. Spokane State Park or Riverside State Park and within Washington State
- Organizations must own the vehicles used to transport youth to and from State Parks. Vehicles must be properly insured, registered in the State of Washington, in legal working condition, and operated by qualified personnel. Vehicles must be able to transport no more than 15 passengers.

Question 1

If awarded a Discover Pass from Riverside State Park Foundation, how will you incorporate trips to Washington's State Parks into your program?

Question 2

State Parks like Riverside, Mount Spokane, and Crawford are public land and visitors can have a negative or positive impact on the parks they visit. How will you convey a message of sustainable use and stewardship to the youth in your program? Would you or your staff need support or resources to help convey this message?

Question 3

Field trips, especially trips to natural parks and wild lands, are all about risk management. What supports, systems, and policies do you have in place to reduce risk and keep kids safe while on trips to Washington's State Parks?

Question 4

You're on a field trip to Riverside State Park with 13 children ages 6-8 years old. You are about 15 minutes down the trail when a first grader tells you that they need to go "number 2", what do you do?

I understand that (1) passes must be used for organization/program vehicles and activities only; (2) passes are good for 12 months ending on the date listed on the Discover Pass; (3) awarded programs must be open to all youth regardless of race, religion, gender, national origin, marital status of their families, sexual orientation, gender identity, political ideology, or ability; (4) awarded programs must comply with reporting requirements, including but not limited to Parks visited, hours spent within Parks, number of children and youth accessing the Parks, activities experienced within Parks; (5) Riverside State Park Foundation, Washington State Parks and any of their agents, employees, volunteers, partners, and contractors will not be held liable for (a) lost or stolen passes; (b) any damage caused through use of products or services granted through this website and programs, be it indirect, special, incidental or consequential damages (including but not limited to damages for loss of business, loss of profits, interruption or the like); (c) direct or indirect losses, arising from any such injury, illness, damage, loss accident, or expense including consequential loss or economic loss however caused.
