<u>Care corner – tips for caring for your home</u>

We interviewed the realtors in our organization, and we came up with a list of action items for caring for your home to avoid costly repairs in the future.....

- 1. Check your Air Conditioner & Furnace routinely and change filters and vents.
- 2. Check batteries in Smoke Detectors, Carbon Monoxide detectors
- 3. Termite inspection every 3 to 5 years. Quarterly Pest Control Maintenance

4. Consider getting a Home Warranty – some plans allow you to pay monthly or yearly. When you have an issue or in need of a repair, their vendors are licensed in their fields of expertise.

- 5. Power wash your home, minimally every 2 years
- 6. Paint the outside of your home every 7 to 10 years. Paint inside as needed and desired.
- 7. Gutters Make sure you remove leaves and debris, if you have gutters
- 8. Leaks Fix leaks immediately to avoid mold issues
- 9. Keep your dryer vent clean
- 10. Clean ceiling fans and bathroom fans
