

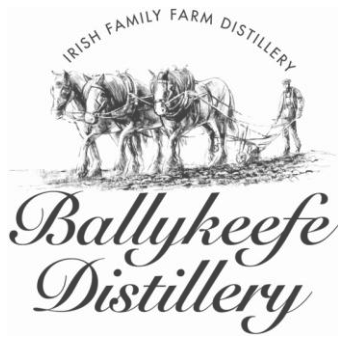
ISLE OF HARRIS DISTILLERY

On the small island of Harris in the Outer Hebrides of Scotland, Isle of Harris Distillers Ltd. was established in 2015 to create the island's first 'legal' distillery, acting as a catalyst for the economic regeneration of their community of less than 2,000 people. Isle of Harris Distillers began with their award-winning Isle of Harris Gin, followed by The Hearach, their single malt scotch whisky, and now they debut an incredible second expression of The Hearach: *100% First-Fill Oloroso Cask Matured*.

– From FIELD to GLASS –

BALLYKEEFE IS THE FIRST Irish Single Estate Family Farm Distillery in over 200 years, where all barley is sown, grown, harvested and distilled on the Ging family farm.

The Ging Family trace their unbroken farming lineage back to the golden age when family farm distilleries were dotted across the Irish countryside. Located in the lush green countryside close to Ireland's medieval capital, Killkenny City, Ballykeefe has the distinction of being the area from which the first written account of distilling in Ireland is recorded in 1324 in the Red Book of Ossory.

Ballykeefe produces their spirits in small batches in bespoke, handcrafted Italian copper stills built by the renowned Barison Family. Every spirit is a Super Premium, hearts-only distiller's cut, which means all heads and tails are discarded, with the emphasis on quality and not quantity.



SINGLE MALT IRISH WHISKEY

NOSE: A Gentle nose with notes of Toasted Oak, Citrus and Coconut, resolving to Apple Sponge Cake.

TASTE: At first, Malt and Fruit dominate with Mango and a hint of ripe Banana. Then Toffee Apple fading to Crème Brûlée.

FINISH: Long finish with notes of Apple Custard and a hint of Cloves.

SINGLE POT STILL IRISH WHISKEY

NOSE: Warm inviting nose with Caramel Toffee notes, Soft Oak Vanilla, Malt Cereal and a hint of Coconut.

HISTORY:

The first mention of a distillery by the loch dates to 1814, and though the original distillery, near Tarbet, is sadly now lost to the mists of whisky history, the current Loch Lomond Distillery owes its creation in 1965 to the former proprietors of Littlemill Distillery, situated in Bowling, merely a few miles towards Glasgow.

WINEMAKING:

Loch Lomond's focus on quality is unwavering. The distillery owns its own cooperage, ensuring that barrel repairs and charring are carried out to an exacting standard, so every cask is perfect for maturing our Loch Lomond spirit.

TASTING NOTES:

This 12-Year-Old Single Malt has delicious orchard fruit notes of pear & peach layered with a honey-vanilla sweetness and a hint of soft smoke on the finish in the typical style of Loch Lomond Whiskies. Aged in three types of American Oak casks – bourbon, refill and recharred.

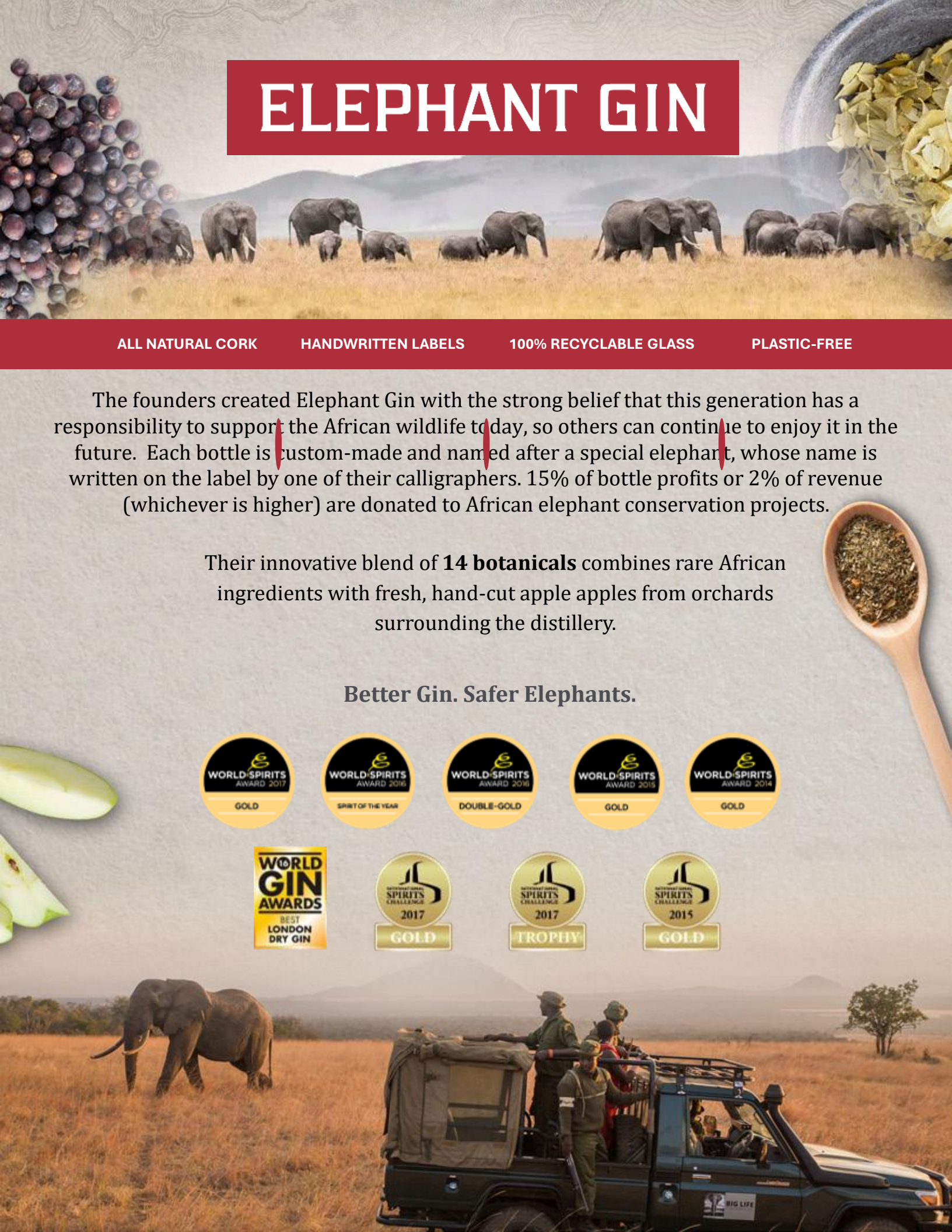

The elegantly designed bottles are carrying the names of the so-called Magnificent Seven: the strongest and most impressive elephants known to Kruger National Park, South Africa – these precious bull elephants all bear tusks weighing more than 50kg each. Elephant Gin wants these legends to live on by naming the batches of Elephant Strength after them, telling their tale in commemoration.

TASTING NOTES

An intense initial blast of fresh aroma and a natural sweetness, complimented with a full bodied botanical backbone and perfectly balanced juniper finish.

The color is ruby red, bright and deep.

THE TERROIR
Its terroir present a strong dominance of clay (over 30%), with deep croups. The result of parcel-by-parcel selection, allow the search for optimum ripeness of Sauvignon Blanc grapes.

THE WINEMAKING
Sauvignon Blanc grapes ripen very early and need to be picked at a precise time, determined by tasting the fruit before harvesting, in order to obtain the full intensity characteristic of this grape variety. The grapes are picked during the night to preserve the freshness of the fruit. They are delicately pressed upon arrival at the winery and vinified in temperature-controlled stainless-steel vats at a cool temperature to preserve the fullness and freshness of the flavors. After light fining, bottling is carried out early to preserve the fresh and fruity character of MAJESTIC ESPRIT.

THE TASTING NOTES
Its robe is pale yellow with golden reflections.
Its expressive, fine and elegant nose reveals floral notes, acacia, honeysuckle and white flesh fruit such as pear.
The attack on the palate is round, velvety, charming and then the wine evolves towards a beautiful balance between acidity and sweetness.
The floral finish leaves a sensation of aromatic sweetness and delicacy.

THE FOOD & WINE PAIRING
MAJESTIC ESPRIT will be a perfect match for an aperitif, with sushi or a seafood plate.

HISTORY:

M. Haslinger & Fils is the latest Brut Champagne from the house of G. H. Martell. A Pinot Noir and Meunier dominant cuvée with a pale-yellow color, and balanced vivacity on the palate. The Rapeneau family and the G.H. Martel Group are one of the last family-run champagne businesses operating on their scale. For five generations now, the family has managed to forge special ties with all partners, both with winegrower friends and with buyers, to become one of the key players on the champagne market.

WINEMAKING:

Dosage: 10g/l

TASTING NOTES:

Pale yellow in color. The nose presents white fruit with hints of lemon and citrus. The wine offers a balanced vivacity on the palate, followed by a satisfying chalk finish.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC , Italy

TERROIR:

The winery vineyards are located in the hills with perfect south-east aspecting at 120-200 metres (400-650 feet) altitude. Soils are clay and limestone, rich in humus and nutrients. In Villamagna, the De Cerchio Family grows its Pecorino, Passerina and Trebbiano varieties but Montepulciano is the monarch.

VINIFICATION:

Growing environmental awareness persuaded the family to adopt organic winegrowing practices throughout its estates. Respect for natural cycles, non-invasive growing techniques and work in the rows that is attentive to showcasing the native and authenticity traits of each district have been at the forefront of the De Cerchio family philosophy over the years.

TASTING NOTES:

" The nose is fresh, cool and lightly herbaceous, with aromas of damp earth, wet stones, tart blackberries, coffee grinds and fresh thyme. Ripe black cherries and sweet blackberries define the palate, until a dark chocolate finish. Tannins are dense and polished, while acid sleekly outlines the palate of a wine that perfectly straddles the space between intrigue and simple pleasure. "

HISTORY:

Renowned worldwide as one of the pillars of Rioja, the origins of Bodega Marqués del Silvo are deeply linked to the development of the appellation. Located 50km from the historic city of Logroño, the bodega is surrounded by 150 hectares of extremely well-kept and carefully managed vineyards alongside the Ebro River. Located in a unique environment between the vineyards and mountains, the cellar crafts a range of high-quality wines, including the unrivaled Marqués del Silvo Reserva and Gran Reserva, which have received national and international recognition since the very first vintage.

WINEMAKING:

Fermented at controlled temperature in stainless steel tanks. Clarified, filtered and transferred to the barrel. Aged in French medium toast and American oak barrels medium toast during 30 months + 12 months in bottle before release.

TASTING NOTES:

"Bright game. Perfumed, slightly high-toned aromas of blackberry, licorice, wild herbs and elegant vanilla. Extremely long, with resonating sweetness, gently tannic and very long finish.."
