1. You may contact your mentor through best mode of communication you both discuss: email, phone, Skype, etc....
2. Your mentor will be available to answer questions regarding school or career opportunities throughout the academic year.
3. United Natives will provide your mentor with your transcripts at the beginning of the academic year and current grade reports at the end of every semester or quarter. Your mentor will review your grades and use them as a reference in order to provide you with individual guidance and support.
4. Your mentor will provide you academic advice, guidance, and recommendations as needed.
5. You will notify your mentor if you are in need of tutoring or counseling services at your campus.
6. You and your mentor will maintain a strict academic/professional relationship.
7. If you are presented with a situation that falls outside of the parameters of a professional mentor-mentee relationship, you will immediately notify a member of the United Natives staff.
8. You will complete an evaluation of your mentor at the end of the academic year.
9. You will complete an evaluation of the United Natives mentorship program at the end of the academic year to improve programming goals/objectives.
