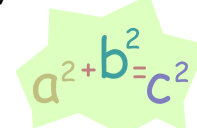
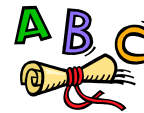

St. Joseph of Cupertino School is a Catholic, parish school dedicated to teaching the whole child: intellectual, spiritual, emotional, moral, social, cultural, and physical. We are a community, which fosters a sense of belonging and honors the unique personality and gifts of each child. We work in partnership with our families because children benefit when they see and experience a supportive, positive relationship between school and home. Learn more about St. Joseph of Cupertino School:

- Credentialed teachers in all grade levels
- Strong and challenging academic program (our students score in the upper percentiles in standardized testing, do well on high school entrance exams, and are successful in their high school programs)
- Full-day Kindergarten which gives us time to focus on strong academics and positive social skills
- Junior Jaguars Preschool which provides a positive learning experience in a nurturing, child-centered environment, with loving teachers in a state-of-the-art facility
- Peaceful environment which stresses prayer, spirituality, respect, generosity, and gratitude
- Full-time Religion Coordinator; daily religious instruction; class retreat days; morning assemblies every day during which we pray together, celebrate special events, and honor children's achievements
- Students plan and fully participate in school, parish, and First Friday liturgies: Music Ministry, liturgical dance/movement, lectors, cantors, altar servers, student ushers
- Active Outreach/Christian Service Program which stresses generosity to and concern for those in need
- Classroom aides at all grade levels and in all subject areas
- Departmentalized program for Grades 6-8, which allows students to have teachers who specialize in language arts, social studies, math, and science
- Advanced math program (including high school algebra) taught by full-time credentialed teachers



- Science lab with specialized science teachers
- Enrichment programs in math and reading, including a Project Center Club which participates in numerous enrichment opportunities (e.g., Tech Challenge, Robotics Team).
- Comprehensive reading and math intervention programs which ensure that students are performing at grade level
- Older/younger student "Buddy Program," which fosters a nurturing, gentle atmosphere, and encourages our older students to be positive role models
- Extended care facilities that are open from 7:00 - 8:15 a.m. before school, and until 6:00 p.m. after school
- Full-time Fine Arts Director, art teacher, music teacher, Spanish teacher, and P.E. teachers for all grades
- A strong focus on technology: A fully equipped Computer Lab and three Mobile Computer Labs with MacBooks and MacBook Airls; two iPad carts holding 50 iPads total; SMART interactive boards in 11 classrooms; 1:1 iPad Program for Grade 8 with plans for extending to 7th Grade this year; SMART Response System, LCD projectors and document cameras in every classroom, full-time computer teacher for Grades K-8, and a specialized aide who helps teachers integrate technology into lessons; computer centers in the classrooms and library
- Full-time librarian; teacher resource center; and a well-equipped library open to all students during the school day and after school
- State certified and licensed special education teacher; testing and tutoring services available
- Licensed, on-site Family Counselor's services available
- Active Student Council program, which encourages positive, spirited, and ethical leadership among our youth
- Student-run recycling program, which fosters respect for our natural resources
- Health screening services provided
- Well-maintained school plant, large grass field, updated playground equipment
- Many family oriented community-building activities (e.g., Cupertino Carnival, International Night, Spaghetti Dinner, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Dining for Dollars Evenings, Skating Party, Family Barbecue, etc.)
- Before and after-school extracurricular programs: band, advanced Spanish, Computer Club, Math Club, Music Ministry, chess, drama, Yearbook, cheerleading, Art Club, Tech Challenge, Robotics/Lego Challenge, Geography Club
- Active after-school sports program for children (basketball, soccer, volleyball, softball, flag football) and Sports Boosters Club for adults
- Hot lunch offered everyday (optional, purchased by student)
