From the Desk of Pastor Janet

"I waited patiently for the Lord; he turned to me and heard my cry.

Happy New Year 2021! May the verse above be our guide for this New Year.

We all feel like 2020 was a year of waiting for God to move. And maybe we have not been very patient. Waiting for God to help us is not easy, but let's look at the benefits that David received from waiting on God.

1. God lifted David out of his despair. If we look to God, we will be lifted from despair as we center on God and not our troubles.
2. God set David's feet on a rock. Sometimes we stand on the uncertainty of today instead of trusting in Jesus and standing on the firm foundation of Jesus Christ.

Safety Reminders During the Pandemic

Living through a pandemic is not something that any of us thought we would ever do, but here we are. We've been in this pandemic for about ten months now. So, just as a reminder, remember these safety guidelines for worship:

- If you are sick for any reason, please do not attend in-person worship
- As you enter, you must agree to the following:
 1. That you have not had 2 or more of the following symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days:
 - Fever
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Chills
 - Persistent cough
 - Flu-like symptoms
 - Diarrhea or intestinal upset
 - Fatigue
 - Sore throat
 - Headache
 - Muscle pain
 - Recent loss of taste or smell
 2. That you have not been in contact with anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (identified in #1) in the past 14 days.
 3. That you have not tested positive for COVID-19, nor are you awaiting test results, nor have you tested positive and have not subsequently had complete resolution of COVID-19 symptoms.
 4. That you will immediately notify the pastor if, after attending this event, you develop 2 or more symptoms of COVID-19, and will

avoid contact with others, and will seek medical attention.

- Put on your mask while still in your vehicle, and please keep it on until returning to your vehicle
- Maintain a safe social distance of at least 6 feet
- No hugging or handshakes
- Do not pass anything between one another

Please practice these same guidelines during the week so you will remain healthy. The projection is that the number of COVID cases will rise following the Christmas season. Therefore, it is vitally important that we practice safety. You are loved, and we do not want anyone getting sick.

The painter has repaired some of the broken windows, painted the trim around the windows, painted the doors and the trim work. There were more broken windows than anticipated and there was paint left. Gary suggested that we have the painter go ahead and paint around the sanctuary walls, the foyer area and the 2 lounges off the foyer. This cost would be around \$5,500. Gary also suggested we get the painter to give us an estimate on repairing the

These lessons are the beginning of a Call to serve God.

**January 3rd
Called to Proclaim
Luke 4:14-22a**

Would you say that our world is hurting today? With everything going on with Covid, I think your response would definitely be a yes. What do we need to do?

In this scripture, Jesus returned to his hometown of Nazareth. Many people referred to him as the "miracle worker". Jesus spoke in the synagogue and stated that he was the Messiah. Many of the people in his hometown didn't believe him. Does that sound familiar when you try to tell someone about Jesus? But yet this is what we are asked to do. Proclaim that Jesus is the answer to all of our troubles that we may encounter. What joy to share with others! Make this your mission. Tell as many people as you can about the good news that Jesus brings and how he has changed your life.

**January 10th
Called to Follow
Luke 5:1-11**

What is your mission in life? Do you have one? Jesus had more and more followers listening to the good word. In this scripture it tells of Simon Peter, who had a boat used for fishing, near where Jesus was talking. Jesus asked Simon to take him in the boat away from the shore where he continued to speak. He then asked Simon to take him to the deep water and drop the nets. Simon told Jesus that they did

not have any luck catching fish but said he would do it because Jesus asked him too. What a large amount of fish they caught but Simon told Jesus that he was a sinful man. Jesus reassured him and told him that he could now fish for people. Simon seeing and believing became a faithful follower of Jesus no questions asked. Perhaps we should become more like Simon!

**January 17th
Called in Authority
Mark 2:1-12**

Jesus had done a lot of healing prior to the trip to Capernaum which is where this scripture takes us. So, when news got out where he was people from all over came. Some men were determined for Jesus to heal their friend who was paralyzed so they devised a way to get him to Jesus. Jesus saw the man and said to him "Your sins are forgiven." The men knew this was wrong because only God could forgive sins. Jesus then explained that God can forgive sins and He was doing the same here on earth. Jesus did heal the man but which is more important...spiritual healing or physical healing. With God we have a wholeness because we are Christians. Are we asking for the right healing? Think about it.

Called for the World's Belief
John 17:14-24**
