SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSONS FOR OCTOBER 2021 CALLED TO PRAISE GOD

October 3
Make a Joyful Noise
Psalm 100

Psalm 100 begins by telling us we should praise God by being joyful and heartfelt. Being loud in our praise shows we truly care. Everyone should be joyful and it is up to us to share this good news with everyone we meet. We can show this by being happy when we are doing things for the Lord. Make your time serving the Lord a delight and not just a chore. By being joyful, sharing this with others, and being cheerful about our service we become more in touch with God.

God is truly worth worshipping. Too many people worship and praise idols. Scripture tells us that only God is worthy of this praise. But don't give up on those idol worshippers, remember they can ask for repentance if they are led to God and away from their idols. Make a JOYFUL noise and know that God truly cares.

October 10

Praise God for Justice and Righteousness

Psalm 9:1-12

David starts this Psalm by thanking God for all he had done in his life. David had many enemies in his life and how God had seen him through all of those times. David knew that God is the judge and it is no use opposing him. God is there for each of you...good times and bad times. God knows when you are going through bad times and he is there to help you. God will never abandon you as long as you seek him. What we need to remember is to praise God not only in bad times but also in good times. David said to lift your voice and praise God.

Give Thanks for Deliverance

Psalm 107:1-9, 39-43
