


THINGS TO KNOW & Do

REGISTRATION FOR MISS AMERICA, STATE & LOCAL:

1. Age Eligibility

Eligibility

2. Headshot Phot: can be a selfie taken on a cell phone.
3. Interview Fact Sheet: Sample Provided
4. Social Initiative Essay: 1 page on a cause that is dear to your heart:
Sample and instructions Provided.
5. Opening Number Outfit: will be a cocktail dress
6. Fitness Routine: just modeling in the Miss America Rebel Ware: Miss America RED COLLECTION is required to compete in a Miss America Local. – See Handout
7. Talent – 90 seconds – See Handout
8. Evening Gown
9. On Stage Question – will be in either your private interview outfit or opening number dress
