





PROGRAMME 2023/24



What is the programme?

- It's a financial education programme aimed at post 16 students
- It is delivered over 2 years
- By the end of the programme >85% of students feel more able to manage their personal finances
- We have been delivering sessions on financial education since 2011
- We have been working with The Jack Petchey Foundation since 2020



How many sessions are there?

- The programme is delivered by one of our facilitators over 4 sessions
- Each session is either 1 hour (interactive), or 75 minutes (superinteractive) - you choose
- We will attend school a maximum of 4 times throughout the year



What's the difference between interactive and super interactive?

- Each interactive session with the exception of student finance will have a student activity embedded into it
- Super interactive will also use Kahoot quizzes and films



What audience is it aimed at?

- 3 of the sessions are aimed at year 12 students
- 1 of the sessions are aimed at year 13 students
- The programme is designed for the WHOLE year group - we would expect a minimum of 75% attendance



Do we get to choose topics?

- Year 12 choose three from:
 - Student Finance
 - Tax & Pensions
 - Budgeting & Earning Extra Money
 - Cryptocurrencies & NFTs
- Year 13 choose one from:
 - Any of the above
 - Credit cards & Credit Ratings
 - Flat Sharing + Saving & Investing



What if we are a SEND school or a PRU?

- We will tailor a programme specifically designed to work for your students
- We will consult with you before we start and show you our materials before we deliver - just to make sure we have got it right



What if we want a different presenter?

- All of our presenters are chosen because they are great at what they do
- Very occasionally things might not work out, so if that's the case let us know and we can bring somebody else in



How can students and schools tell you what we think?

- We are working with Bean Research to compile our impact report
- During each session students will be asked to complete a short online quiz. They will also have an opportunity to leave feedback on the session.
- Schools will be asked to complete an expectation survey on sign up and an evaluation survey after programme completion.
- These will take around 3 minutes each and will be done online.



What happens after the programme finishes?

- We will forward each school the names of their students who completed the online quiz along with their feedback
- Each school will be able to print off a WWJP certificate for presentation to each student



Is there a cost to the school?

- Jack Petchey Foundation heavily subsidise the cost of the programme for each school
- There is a one off contribution of £150 from each school which covers the whole programme



How do we book a place?
