

WHO ATTENDS

Buyers/Sourcing Agents for Manufacturers of Apparel, Accessories, and Home Products, Private Label Retailers, Party/Event Planners, Retail Fabric Stores, and others that buy fabric and trimmings wholesale and/or source domestic contractors and service providers.

Attendees to **The Fabric Shows** range from **Large Well-Known Brands** (including Levi's, Gap, Urban Outfitters); **Private Label Retailers** (e.g. Dillards, Macy's, Target); **Designer Labels** (e.g. Norma Kamali, Sara Campbell, Tory Burch); **Costume Departments for Shows, Museums, Theme Parks** (e.g. Disney, Metropolitan Opera House, Universal). Plus, many other well-known users of Apparel and Home Textiles.

WHO EXHIBITS

To exhibit at The Fabric Shows, exhibitors must have a marketing office in the USA or Canada and fit one or more of the following categories.

Exhibitor Categories

1. Wholesale Producers & Suppliers of Textiles (including Mills, Converters, Importers, and Distributors). Materials are globally produced. Many exhibitors stock fabric and trims in North America. Exhibitors also produce custom items to order, most with low minimum requirements, and ship worldwide.
2. Contractors – Cut & Sew, Finishers (e.g. print & dyeing, embellishments for Apparel, Accessories, Home Furnishings). These exhibitors must have production facilities in North America. Some produce samples/small lots in the USA or Canada and offer production for larger lots in Asia or elsewhere.
3. Service Providers - such as consultants, pre-production services, testing labs, trade organizations.

The Fabric Shows - From 2012 to 2026

Our first show in New York City (February 2012) was a phenomenal success! That success has followed us through the pandemic shutdown and into the challenging years that have followed. We have a loyal group of exhibitors and attendees who value our shows. **The Fabric Shows** continue to welcome our original group of exhibitors (including Carr Textile, Ermani Group, Kendor Textiles). In addition to our core group of returning exhibitors, a few new exhibitors are accepted for each show. Selection is based on the company profile, including the products offered and their value to our attendees.

The **New York Fabric Show** is held twice a year (January & July). The next show in New York is July 29 & 30, 2026. Additional shows are scheduled in cities across the USA each year, including Miami and San Francisco. The **San Francisco Fabric Show** has been taking place once a year in November since 2012 (excluding the pandemic shutdown). On November 8 & 9, 2026, we'll be back in San Francisco with our annual show featuring more exhibits, seminars and events. Our 2027 show schedule is being planned now. The calendar begins with the **New York Fabric Show** in January and ends the year, as always, in San Francisco – with new stops along the way drawing in buyers from across North America and beyond!
