

Spiritual Gifts Assessment



A tool designed to help you discover where God has gifted you to serve in the church.

DIRECTIONS:

This spiritual gift assessment can be a helpful tool for identifying areas where God may have uniquely equipped believers for ministry. The gifts listed below are drawn primarily from *Romans 12:3–8*, *1 Corinthians 12:4–11, 27–31*, *Ephesians 4:11–12*, and *1 Peter 4:10–11*. Please take time to read through these passages before completing the assessment.

Instructions: Rate each statement from 1–5.

- 1 = Never True of Me
- 2 = Rarely True of Me
- 3 = Sometimes True of Me
- 4 = Often True of Me
- 5 = Consistently True of Me



This is not a test so there are no wrong answers. This is for Christians of all ages.

For each category, place a number in the blank after each statement.

Add the numbers up and place that number in the blank that says "Total".

This will likely take some time for you to accurately fill out the form.

However, as you fill it out, try not to think too hard about each particular question. Oftentimes, the first answer you think of is usually the correct one.

You are welcome to score your own assessment for yourself or simply turn it into Pastor Andy, and he will make the assessment for you.

Based upon your score, you will have a very good idea what ministries are best suited for your spiritual gifts.

1. Biblical confirmation
2. Pastoral leadership
3. Prayer
4. Service in the local church
5. Affirmation from other believers
6. Spiritual fruit and effectiveness in ministry

The New Testament emphasizes not merely discovering gifts but faithfully using them to build up the body of Christ (*Romans 12:6–8; 1 Corinthians 12; Ephesians 4:11–16; 1 Peter 4:10–11*).
