A Letter From The Pastor BY PASTOR ANDY MOORE

The Psalmist wrote in Psalm 121:1-2 – "I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come? My help comes from the Lord, the One who made heaven and earth." I have been reflecting on these words every day for the past week. As I write this, our nation is still reeling from the shocking assassination of a popular, leading voice for many of our young people. The murder of Charlie Kirk has prompted a stirring of the soul that most of our young people have never experienced, and for many of our adults, we haven't felt since 9/11/2001.

I still remember vividly how I felt on that day 24 years ago when the soul of our country was deeply wounded. For a time, it seemed that politicians, presidents, lawmakers, and leaders would bend their knee in submission and humility and cry out to God for help. And while we saw that happen for many people, it was short lived, as our nation once again turned her back on God and ignored the warnings of Scripture. Now, 24 years later, almost to the day, we have a new generation that has experienced that same kind of soul-shock that is hard to put into words. I have followed Charlie Kirk for the last ten years. And while I do not wade too deeply into political waters, I have been very concerned with where we are morally and spiritually as a nation. My heart hurts for his wife and two children. I hope you will join me in praying for his family and for all who have been terribly grieved over his death. We are left with only one option: our response. We cannot change what happened to Charlie Kirk, just like we cannot change what happened on 9/11. But we can respond appropriately. Not with force, but with faith. Not with hate, but with love. Not because of unexpected tragedies, but because of unshakeable truths.

Where does our help come from? It comes from the Maker of heaven and earth. Our help comes from the one seated on His throne ruling over His creation with justice, righteousness, and faithfulness. Look to Him and He will sustain your every step. May the Lord bless you today dear friend,
