<p>Biblical Qualifications: I Timothy 3: 8-13</p> <p>Church Qualifications: Nominees must be age 21 or older, having full membership (non-associate member) of Ridge Road Baptist for more than one year (prior to October 1 of the current year), a resident member having not served as deacon in the past year, not having a spouse serving as deacon at the same time, and not having a family member on the church staff.</p> <p>Qualities of an Outstanding Deacon: Deacons are faithfully involved and support church programs by using their spiritual gifts. Additionally, they show leadership by having regular attendance for worship services, Sunday School, business meetings, diaconate meetings, and other church events. Deacons participate in mission projects of the church and financially support the church by giving regularly.
