Another update from Carson and Laura:

We are glad to share that travel went smoothly back to Kanazawa. Thank you for your prayers for the long journey. We returned to an apartment where nearly everything was where we left it besides a few replaceable broken items that had been shaken off shelves sometime in the last week. The supermarket was packed with people, but was stocked with all necessary items. Gasoline was also readily available. Helicopters can be seen and heard taking supplies to the north of the prefecture from time to time, but other than that life seems very normal at the moment in our city. We know, however, that is not the case for all in our region.

At Kanazawa Baptist Church, we will gather tomorrow for worship services in Japanese and English, the first since the earthquake on New Year's Day (Monday). Our English service will have a devoted time of sharing of experiences from the last week as well as guided prayer through scripture to help us better understand the destruction that surrounds us, but also the power of God over all. We hope that this is a time that all who join will know the support of our faith community, but greater still the ever present love of God.

Please continue to pray for Ishikawa and the other prefectures in Hokuriku. The death toll has passed 100 with hundreds still missing. Rain continues to increase the possibility of landslides, especially will the consistent tremors. Water and other resources are still scarce in some temporary facilities and tens of thousands are still without power with freezing temperatures and snow forecasted in the next few days.
