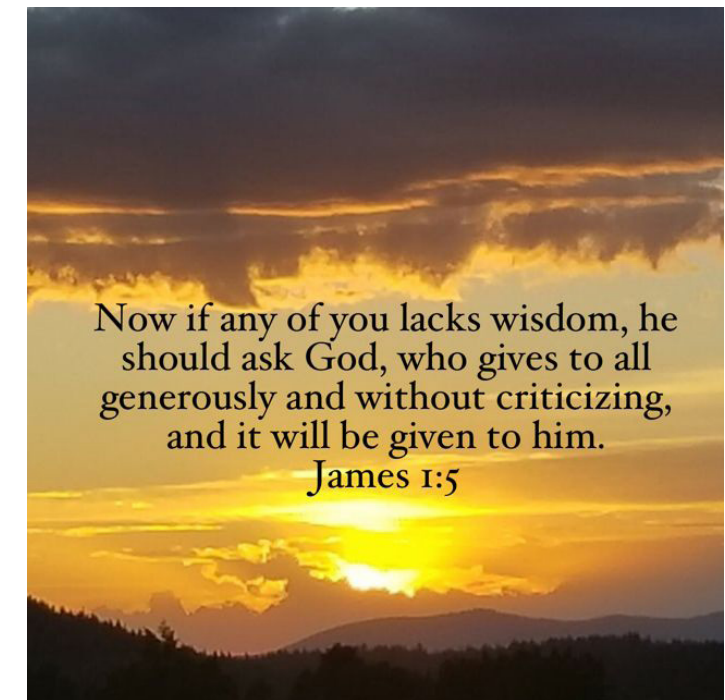

OCTOBER DEACONS' MEETING

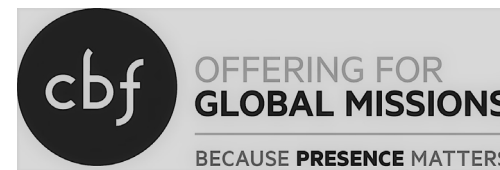
The Diaconate will meet on Monday, October 18, at 6:30 in the Chapel.
