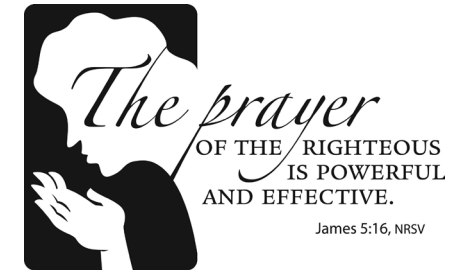
DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME ENDS
