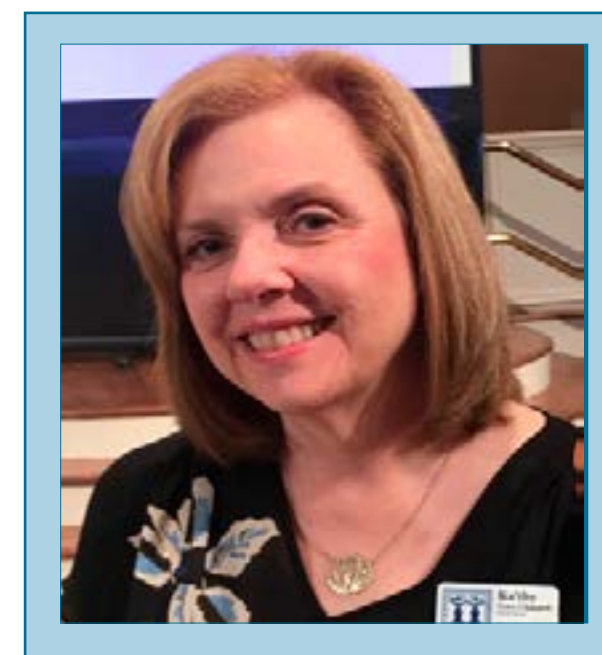

This morning we welcome Ka'thy Gore Chappell (pronounced Kay-thee) was born and raised in Opelika, Alabama and came to faith in the First Baptist Church. Being in a family of strong women, it was natural to her to believe she was called by God into the ministry.

She is a graduate of Auburn University and Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. Currently, she is the Executive Director of the Baptist Women in Ministry of North Carolina and a candidate for the Doctor of Ministry degree program at Central Baptist Theological Seminary in Shawnee, Kansas.

Over the years, she has been the Leadership Development Coordinator with Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of North Carolina, Associate Dean at Baptist Theological Seminary in Richmond, and served North Carolina Baptist churches for over 30 years, including Forest Hills Baptist in Raleigh. She lives in Winston-Salem and has one daughter who is, to no surprise, an ordained Baptist minister.
