Part IV Narrative Description of Your Activities

Reign In Life Ministries, Inc.'s mission is to meet the various needs of persons in need of training in life skills, trade skills, faith-based principles, and discipleship.

Reign In Life Ministries, Inc.'s objective is to assist persons in the transformation of their lives and the community around them, through training in principles, life and trade skills that, remain the foundation of a sustained life, community and Country. We will accomplish this through training people for employment in trades such as electrician, plumbing, landscaping, auto maintenance and repair, and other trades. The program is designed for former inmates, people that have recovered from substance abuse, and other low-income people. We aim to equip those in need with the skills to achieve independence and self-sufficiency.

Applicants interested in participating in the program will go through an interview process. They must demonstrate that they have reformed and have the desire to change their lives and complete the training program. The program will include classroom training as well as hands on training. We will help participants obtain gainful employment and obtain any required industry licenses. Program participants will also participate in biblical training in which we teach them faith-based principles. We will not charge any fees to participate in the program.

Pending available funds, Reign In Life Ministries, Inc. will purchase homes to provide transitional housing for program participants. Participants will live in the homes as they complete the training program. They may stay in the home as they seek permanent housing. We will charge an affordable monthly rent based on the person's income. We will charge a low rent that allows them to save for their own housing. The rent will be approximately \$300 per month. The homes will accommodate six to ten people.

Furthermore, Reign In Life Ministries, Inc. plans to distribute Christian books to schools, shelters, youth groups, and prisons. Pending available funds and resources we plan to distribute the books to approximately three to ten organizations per year. Each organization will receive approximately ten books.

No compensation will be paid to officers or governing body members or related individuals <u>until</u> the <u>organization</u> is <u>operational</u> and <u>successful</u>, and all compensation decisions will be made by a majority of the non-compensated, unrelated members of the organization's governing body. Furthermore, all compensation will be at a fair and reasonable rate and will be comparable to other executives of similar type charitable organizations in similar positions.

A voting member of the governing board who receives compensation, directly or indirectly, from the Organization for services is precluded from voting on matters pertaining to that member's or a related party member's compensation.
