

Mega Training Show Prize List and Entry Form 2019 Hosted by the Avon Pony Club May 4-5, 2019 Windsor Exhibition Grounds

INTRODUCTION

The Mega Training Show, hosted by the Avon Pony Club, is an opportunity for riders of all skill levels to gain experience in the show ring, in a fun and relaxed atmosphere. The Mega Training Show is also a fundraiser for the Avon Pony Club, and your participation, and support, is appreciated. The show will be held over two days – a new format which should reduce the chances of midnight hunter rounds!

The show is held in the Main Arena of the Windsor Exhibition Grounds, making it a great training opportunity for those competitors planning to participate in the Windsor Spring Horse Show (May 16-19, 2019). Indoor warm-up facilities are available in the Mary Henry/Dexter Construction Ring, adjacent to the Main Arena. A canteen, and free parking, are available onsite.

The Avon Pony Club is pleased to welcome Kathleen Nunn as our show judge.

Important Show Information:

- Ribbons will be provided in each class, to 5th place.
- Class sizes will be capped (caps determined by show administration), so be sure to enter early to avoid disappointment.
- Classes with fewer than 3 entries may be canceled or combined with another class.
- Stalls will be available on a first reserved, first served basis. Please bring your own bedding and clean out your stall after use. A fee of \$25 will be charged for stalls that are not left clean prior to departure.
- All competitors must have valid NSEF membership.
- Competitors must wear their ring numbers at all times when mounted.

Specific Class Information:

- Walk-Trot competitors may also enter walk/trot/canter. Walk-trot competitors are also eligible for pole classes, but not crossrail classes.
- Walk/Trot/Canter competitors may enter walk trot, but then are ineligible for cross rail classes. W/T/C competitors who also enter walk trot may enter pole classes.
- Hunter ponies will go back to back, starting with the smalls.
- Maiden Pleasure is only open to horses or ponies who have NOT shown before (green horses/ponies).

- Stall straight stalls \$15, box stall \$20.
- Stall cleaning fee any stall that is not left clean will incur a charge of \$25 per stall.

*As of 2019, the Windsor Agricultural Society will be charging a \$5 fee per horse, per event. This amount is collected by the horse show organizers and sent directly to the Windsor Agricultural Society.
