The Chief Range Officer reserves the right to disqualify any unsafe rifle, ammunition or competitor. Two consecutive shots not on paper <u>will</u> result in disqualification.

Equipment Allowed: In accordance with current CMP rules. Rifles allowed are: (4.1.1-4) Service Rifle, (4.1.5) Match Rifle. This event will be fired as a CMP CUP MATCH/STANDARD COURSE AGGREGATE. Compensators, suppressors, or muzzle brakes are prohibited. Empty chamber indicators and Ear/ Eye Protection are required.

200 yds. SR Target (a) - 300 yds. NRA SR-42 (h) - 600 yds. NRA MR-52 (i). Targets will be changed appropriately. Competitors may be required to perform scoring and pit duty on their assigned relay and target set up after sign-in and target take-down/storage at match conclusion. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Competitors' are expected to bring a presighted rifle; therefore, after two consecutive rounds fail to impact the paper will be disqualified. SHOTMARKER ELECTRONIC targets may be used; if so, shooters will need a smart phone or tablet that is WiFi capable, and pit duty will not apply.

<u>Classifications:</u> CMP High Power classifications will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master class (3.11.8). Scores will be posted to the CMP Competition Tracker web page for classifications or upgrading.
