

BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (BST) ACADEMY
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE CHINO VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND
THE ASSOCIATED CHINO TEACHERS

The Chino Valley Unified School District (“District”) and the Associated Chino Teachers (“A.C.T.”) agree that this Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) addresses the allocation of department chairpersons and student activity/extra duty stipends at the Biomedical Science and Technology (BST) Academy. It is effective on a mutually agreed date and signed by both parties.

1. To address the unique needs and circumstances of the specialized programs within the BST Academy, Secondary Department Chairperson stipend and High School Activity (Level XVIII) and High School Extra Duty stipends for Coaches of Academic Competition Teams (XVII) shall be paid to eligible teachers at the rate outlined in item #4 and in Appendix C of the Collective Bargaining Agreement respectively.
2. Teachers who teach at least four (4) periods within the BST Academy program shall be eligible for consideration for a department chairperson or activity/extra duty stipend.
3. Teachers who teach at least four (4) periods within the BST Academy shall be excluded from Chino High School’s coordinating-member count for purposes of calculating department chairperson stipend amounts.
4. BST Academy shall offer up to four (4) department chairperson stipends and six (6) High School activity/extra duty stipends [two (2) at Level XVIII and four (4) at Level XVII] as described in item #2, to eligible teachers.
5. The parties will agree to meet no later than April 2027 to review the implementation, effectiveness, and the impact of the MOU.
6. This MOU is not precedent setting and shall sunset on June 30, 2027.
7. All components of the current Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Association and District not addressed by the terms of this agreement shall remain in full effect.
