

# PARENTAL PERMISSION TO ENTER MEXICO

Minors under the age of 18 traveling from the United States into Mexico, when not accompanied by both parent (s) or legal guardian (s) need notarized permission to enter Mexico.

Both parent (s) or legal guardian (s) must sign the permission form at a notary office. The signing date must be within 30 days of the border crossing date.
