NYU Langone Medical Center has established the Center for Women’s Health (CWH), a bold step that recognizes that unique health needs of women. Now women can receive accessible, comprehensive and individualized care from NYU’s finest physicians at one location.



The CWH offers enhanced women’s healthcare services in a comfortable, centrally located 14,000-square-foot facility. The center includes 16 private examination rooms, seven consultation rooms and a convertible lecture/workshop space for health and wellness events. Seven full-time physicians and one registered nurse staff the center, which also provides outpatient services including mammography and ultrasound; endoscopy and colonoscopy; bone density testing; and ECHO, cardiac and pulmonary function testing.

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Dr. Nieca Goldberg is a cardiologist and pioneer in the field of women’s heart health. She serves as Clinical Associate Professor of Medicine, Medical Director of the NYU Women’s Heart Program and has been named several times to New York Magazine’s “Best Doctors” list since 2000. In 1999, Dr. Goldberg was the only woman the magazine’s top ten “Hall of Fame of Physicians.”

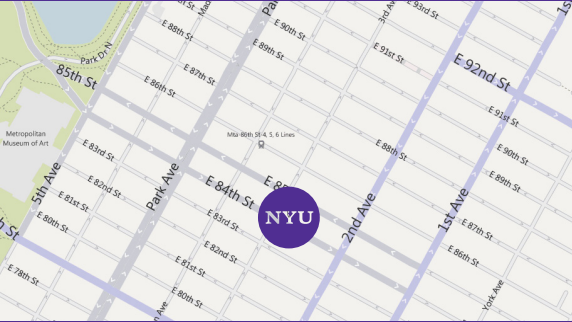
