

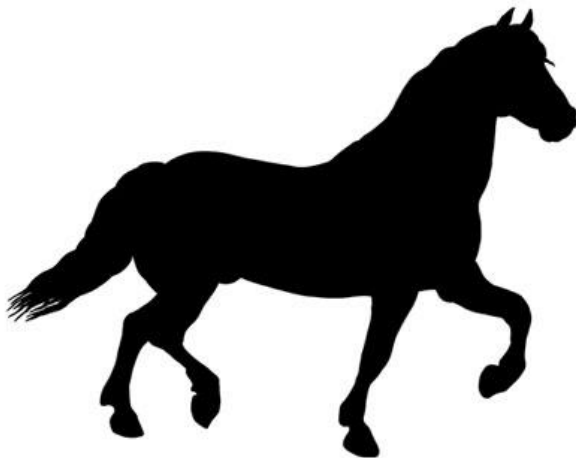

Competitors in **ALL EVENTS** must acquire a number from the Show Secretaries.

The first classes in each ring will start promptly at the time stated. Class times thereafter are approximate but will be adhered to as much as possible and will not begin earlier than stated.

Affiliation to Equifest (www.equifest.co.uk):

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground during August 2020. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF THE SHOW

1. Competitors enter at their own risk. The Organisers cannot be responsible for any accident, loss or injury to any animal, competitor, their assistants, property or spectators however caused.
2. If insufficient entries, age groups may be amalgamated. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or substitute any judge.
3. Hard hats must be worn when mounted with chin straps fastened (incl. Fancy Dress) and correct riding dress is required in the rings. The Show Committee recommend PAS 015. Skull caps are to have a black or navy blue cover. No muckers. The organisers recommend competitors to wear a back protector for all jumping classes, including the clear round ring.
4. Spurs may be worn except in the Gymkhana. No whips in the Gymkhana. Show canes/whips are not to exceed 30" (75cms). Cruelty with whips or spurs or any other cause, at the discretion of the judges, will result in elimination.
5. **NO GALLOPING OUTSIDE THE RINGS.** Competitors are requested to observe the Show's Safety Layout, Rules and Regulations.
6. The Judge's and Organisers' decision is final.
7. A Judge may not consider a pony or horse in any event that he or she has bred, sold, leased, or produced, or his/her immediate family or employees, or from whom financial gain has been received.
8. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 which will be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
9. Competitors can only enter their own age groups in the Gymkhana events and must ride the same pony.
10. Competitors should report to the Collecting Ring Steward immediately a class is called. Those not present may be excluded from the class.
11. Competitors in jumping classes may arrange a time to jump with the Collecting Ring Steward if they are entered in another class, but please note that the jumping classes will not be delayed.
12. All classes are off the Leading Rein unless otherwise stated. Riders being led in one event cannot enter another off the lead.
13. Horses and Ponies entered in ridden classes must be 4 years old or over unless otherwise stated. Age is calculated from 1st January in the year of birth.
14. Rider's age for entry is 1st January in the current year.
15. Horses and Ponies may be measured. An additional 1cm will be allowed for shoes.

16. All Challenge cups and trophies are perpetual and **MUST BE RETURNED UPON REQUEST** and, in any event, **NO LATER THAN FOUR WEEKS BEFORE THE SHOW, UNDAMAGED AND IN A CLEAN CONDITION.** **Any damage to cups or trophies must be paid for.** Names and addresses of winners will be required before any trophy is awarded.
17. Please keep any dogs brought to the Show on leads at all times.
18. The Committee reserves the right to cancel the Show on the preceding Friday if the going is deemed to be too wet or, if any other unforeseen circumstances arise beyond the Organisers' control. In the event of cancellation, advance entry fees will be returned less 25% to cover costs.

EQUINE FLU

The following recommendation from the British Equine Federation for Equine Competitions and Training Events applies to this show.

The British Equine Federation (BEF) are recommending that your horse (or pony) has received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza, given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. Only these two injections need to have been given before a horse (or pony) can attend. In addition if sufficient time has elapsed, a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year apart. They also strongly advise that if the attending horses' (or ponies') last vaccination was longer ago than six months that you discuss an additional booster vaccination with your vet.

Any horse not complying with the vaccination rules should not be unloaded nor any horses travelling with it and they will not be allowed to participate in any session.

All competitors must ensure their horses (or ponies) are vaccinated according to the above recommendations and that their passports are up to date. Passports may be subject to a spot check on the day.

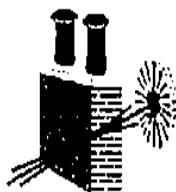

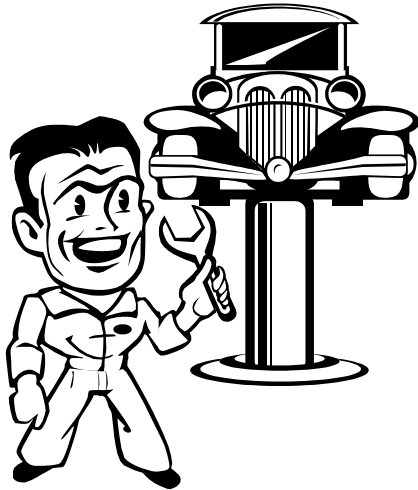

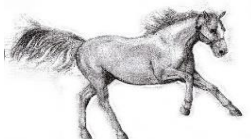
