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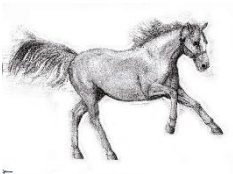

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GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF THE SHOW

1. Competitors enter at their own risk. The Organisers cannot be responsible for any accident, loss or injury to any animal, competitor, their assistants, property or spectators however caused.
2. If insufficient entries, age groups may be amalgamated. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or substitute any judge.
3. Hard hats must be worn when mounted with chin straps fastened (incl. Fancy Dress) and correct riding dress is required in the rings. The Show Committee recommend PAS 015 (2011) hats. Skull caps are to have a black or navy blue cover. Correct footwear for riding, no wellingtons or equivalent. The organisers strongly recommend competitors to wear a body protector for all jumping classes, including the clear round ring. Body protectors must meet the BETA 2018 (Level 3) safety standard.
4. Spurs may be worn except in the Gymkhana. No whips in the Gymkhana. Show canes/whips are not to exceed 30" (75cms). Cruelty with whips or spurs or any other cause, at the discretion of the judges, will result in elimination.
5. No head or body cameras are to be worn by competitors.
6. **NO GALLOPING OUTSIDE THE RINGS.** Competitors are requested to observe the Show's Safety Layout, Rules and Regulations. Please be courteous and safe to each other at all times. Please take special care in warm up areas and at ring entrances.
7. The Judge's and Organisers' decision is final.
8. A Judge may not consider a pony or horse in any event that he or she has bred, sold, leased, or produced, or his/her immediate family or employees, or from whom financial gain has been received.
9. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £30.00 which will be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
10. Competitors can only enter their own age groups in the Gymkhana events and must ride the same pony.
11. Competitors should report to the Collecting Ring Steward immediately a class is called. Those not present may be excluded from the class.
12. Competitors in jumping classes may arrange a time to jump with the Collecting Ring Steward if they are entered in another class, but please note that the jumping classes will not be delayed.
13. All classes are off the Leading Rein unless otherwise stated. Riders being led in one event cannot enter another off the lead.
14. Horses and Ponies entered in ridden classes must be 4 years old or over unless otherwise stated. Age is calculated from 1st January in the year of birth.

15. The lower age limit for a rider to enter any class is 4 years old. Young riders on lead rein should be accompanied by an adult at all times, including within the showground walkways.
16. Horses and Ponies may be measured. An additional 1cm will be allowed for shoes.
17. **All Cups and Trophies need to be signed for by winners in the secretary's tent. A name, address and contact number, must be supplied and the winner must undertake to return the cup or trophy in good condition no later than four weeks before the following year's Horse Show. Any damage to cups or trophies occurring in the year must be paid for by the signatory.**
18. Please keep any dogs brought to the Show on **short leads at all times.**
19. The Committee reserves the right to cancel the Show on the preceding Friday if the going is deemed to be too wet or, if any other unforeseen circumstances arise beyond the Organisers' control. In the event of cancellation, advance entry fees will be returned less 25% to cover costs.
