Mayor Errick D. Simmons Announces Free Drive-Through COVID-19 Testing

GREENVILLE, Miss. (October 19, 2020) Today, Mayor Errick D. Simmons announces the “It’s Better to Know” free drive-through COVID-19 testing hosted by the Mayor’s Health Council and the Delta Cotton Belles. Free testing will be offered to all comers, asymptomatic and symptomatic, with no required appointment nor pre-screening along with free masks and breast cancer awareness information. This event will take place on Saturday, October 24, 2020 beginning at 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. at Harty Park located at the intersection of Causey Dr. Fairview St. This event is supported by the MS Department of Health, MS Delta Health Collaborative, Sacred Heart Church, Pilgrim Rest Church, and Vessels of Mercy Church.
